Its location is ideal as it is in an area far from large urban centres, close to the sea, which stands out for being a strategic territory in terms of renewable solar, wind and sea-related, tidal and wave energies, as well as its links with water and primary sector in which the Northern Region of Gran Canaria is a reference point on our island.

Where are we located?

The Park is in the municipality of Gáldar, in the island called Gran Canaria, Canary Islands, Spain, European Union, on a publicly owned plot of land with a classification and category of land suitable for the development of the planned activities.

Facilities and spaces

The facilities include offices, laboratories, training rooms, an assembly hall, coworking areas and plots of land for business research projects.

The Park has a main two-storey building of 2.500 m², in addition to a plot area of more than 11.000 m² for testing and trials of innovating and research companies, a privileged place from which to explore the green and blue economies.
